1. Open Space Discussion – Security on Campus – Agenda item #6

2. Welcome and Chair's Remarks

a. Pat Bradshaw welcomed committee members and thanked Robert Cerjanec for chairing the CSC meeting on March 2, 2011. Council members will be sent a note requesting confirmation of 2011-2012 participation in the council.

b. Approval of March 2, 2011 meeting minutes

Robert Cerjanec moved to approve minutes. Seconded by Robert Kilfoyle. Not unanimously approved. Paula Gowdie Rose requested amendments as follows:

Item # 4 – should acknowledge Steve Dranitsaris for providing background information on Mass Notification System

Item #5 – goSafe Program update and feedback – should be “door to door service in the village”.

Item #6 – Review Statistics on website – need to be reviewed and brought back to council.

c. Standing Audit Sub-Committee Report

Pat Bradshaw presented the mandate and report from the first two meetings of the sub-committee. Questions were raised about how to transition new members on to the new committee given some will be graduating. Where possible, new members will be included in the April meeting to help orient them.

d. Pat Bradshaw hi-lighted four recommendations from the METRAC report relating to responsibilities for implementation by the CSC. See attached powerpoint presentation. Rob Kilfoyle explained that CPTED is process of reviewing environmental design to ensure safety. It was proposed that a working group be established in September to start this process and membership will be discussed and whether facilities should be involved as well.

- 4.** Safety Awareness Day was discussed. Overall members felt that it is working well and is beneficial. It was suggested that CSC have a table at the next day and that other safety partners be included, perhaps even the Town and Gown. New ways of engaging Glendon community members need to be considered.
- 5.** Report from CSC to the President was discussed. Members of CSC are encouraged to send comments to Pat Bradshaw. Members reinforced the importance of creating a culture of safety and of education.
